Long Term Needs - Discussion

As a group we identified green space and play areas as a need and wondered if owners of Mobile Home Communities could donate space and if funding would be available for playground equipment.

The subject of Physical Exams and Immunizations was brought up as a need - Sarah shared that Alexian has teams of nurses and outreach assistance workers who could help. This will be a need as we approach next summer. Families still struggle to find places for low cost/free physicals and immunizations. Ideally, these services could be brought in to the Mobile Home park areas.

In thinking about long term needs, the group discussed that we need to consider sustainable solutions, push in support, and getting input from residents and management on what they see as the needs. We also identified the need to promote homeowner associations to give residents tools to advocate for themselves - for sustainability

For the next meeting we will include Terry Nelson from the Mobile Home Parks Association, and resident and management reps from each of the communities (Blackhawk, Oasis, Des Plaines, Willow Way)
