A 2016 SUMMER

- District Outcomes - Create progressions for each of the outcomes and elements (PreK-8 group of staff)
- Subject Area Work
 - Create definitions, elements, and progressions for the applied outcomes
 - Develop the commitments for each subject
 - Create set of understandings for each subject
- Staff participation is welcome and encouraged. The weeks identified for this work are:
 - June 13-17
 - June 20-23
 - July 11-14
- A variety of professional development sessions will be available for interested staff throughout the summer and the calendar will soon be shared

B 2016-2017 1ST SEMESTER

STAFF DIRECTION

- Implement the new district outcomes, applied outcomes, and progressions/rubrics within existing units and organization as included in the curriculum documents folder that is being updated
- Emphasize outcomes/understandings in instructional planning and assessment as opposed to coverage of specific content topics
- Become familiar with the commitments in each area and work with team to incorporate them into practice

OPTION

- As an alternative to the steps outlined above, staff may choose to experiment with creating their own learning experiences within the district outcomes, applied outcomes, beliefs, commitments, and understandings

CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT PROCESS

- Finalize understanding progressions for each subject area
- Learning Experience Development teams will develop and pilot a learning experience, compile feedback, and revise the learning experience in preparation for 2nd Semester implementation

C 2016-2017 2ND SEMESTER

STAFF DIRECTION WINTER

- Implement one fully developed learning experience (provided to staff by the Learning Experience Development team)
 - K-5 - science
 - 6-8 - one per subject area (except math)

CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT PROCESS

- Learning Experience Development teams will develop and pilot a second learning experience, collect and compile staff feedback, and revise the learning experience

STAFF DIRECTION SPRING

- Implement a second fully developed learning experience (will be provided to staff by the Learning Experience Development team)
 - K-5 - social science
 - 6-8 - another learning experience per subject area (including math at 6-8 as district-wide pilot)

D 2017 SUMMER

- Learning Experience Development teams will be working to develop remaining learning experiences, collecting and compiling staff feedback, reviewing student work samples and data, and revising the learning experiences in preparation for advanced level of implementation as described below.

E 2017-2018 SCHOOL YEAR

- Elementary - Implementation of new learning experiences in science, social science, and math
- Junior High - Implementation of new learning experiences in all areas

F 2018-2019 SCHOOL YEAR

- Full implementation of all subjects at all grades
