



RESOLUTION: PREPARATION OF 2018 TAX LEVY AND SETTING THE DATE FOR THE PUBLIC HEARING

Background

Recommendation

Cook County taxing districts adhere to the Truth in Taxation Law (35 ILCS 200/18-55; Division 2). This law requires the District to estimate the necessary amount of its aggregate levy not fewer than 20 days before taking action to adopt the levy. If the estimated levy exceeds 105% of the amount extended on the aggregate levy of the preceding year, then the District must follow the specific public notification requirements.

Regardless of the levy amount, the District considers it a good practice to continue with the spirit of the Truth in Taxation Law by complying with notification and public hearing requirements. This resolution authorizes the Administration to proceed with the preparation of the 2018 levy and to announce the public hearing 2018 date of November 19, 2018.

RESOLUTION: APPOINTMENT OF SUPERINTENDENT TO CAUSE A
BUDGET TO BE PREPARED FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020

Background

Section 5/17-1 of the <u>Illinois School Code</u> requires an annual budget to be prepared in tentative form by "... some person or persons designated by the board, and in such tentative form shall be made conveniently available to public inspection for at least 30 days prior to final action thereon." Members of the Board of Education will designate the Superintendent to cause a tentative budget to be prepared for the 2019-20 fiscal year based on the following budget parameters:

- In accordance with Board approved Fund Balance Policy;
- Allocate costs associated with implementing the District Strategic Plan;
- Project staffing based on enrollment projections, proposed staffing plans and frameworks;
- Allocate salary costs based on Board authorized percentage increases and negotiated agreements;
- Allocate insurance benefit costs based on projections and plans as identified through the Insurance Committee process;
- Allocate facilities, equipment and capital improvement project costs adopted by the Board of Education;
- Allocate funds to support District technology plan;
- Allocate funds to support District initiatives;
- Restructure budgets as deemed necessary to meet financial goals;
- Allocate resources in alignment with other assumptions and strategies as set forth in the Long-Term Financial Plan, representative of the Board's goal to maintain its State Financial Profile Recognition status.

In addition, the Local Government Travel Expense Control Act, 50 ILCS 150/10, and Board of Education Policies 2:125 and 5:60 requires the Board of Education to review the maximum allowable reimbursement amount (MARA). The adoption of this resolution will set that amount equal to the budgeted travel expenses amount for the 2019-20 fiscal year.

RESOLUTION: FY 2019-20 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS TO BE CHARGED TO THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE FUND

Members of the Board of Education completed a review of proposed capital improvement projects for fiscal year 2019-20 during the September 24, 2018 Board of Education meeting.

The Board of Education has agreed to support an estimated \$1,506,150 in district-wide capital improvement projects to be charged to the Operation and Maintenance Fund, scheduled for completion during the 2019-20 fiscal year.

The cost for completion of district-wide building improvements, to be charged to the 2019-20 fiscal year Operations and Maintenance Fund, is estimated at \$1,506,150.



RESOLUTION: AWARD OF BID FOR MAINTENANCE VEHICLES

BASIC BID INFORMATION

NUMBER OF BIDS ISSUED: 8
NUMBER OF SEALED BIDS RECEIVED: 3

DATE OF BID OPENING: August 1, 2018

Background

A total of \$100,000 was estimated for the replacement of two maintenance vehicles as part of the 2018-2019 adopted budget. The replacement of these vehicles coincides with the long-range plan for replacing vehicles on a regularly scheduled basis to minimize repair costs and maximize trade-in/resale value.

The Bid called for the purchase of two (2) 2019 Chevrolet Silverado 3500HD pickup trucks. One of the utility vehicles is equipped with a wood platform body and the other is equipped with a service box. Both vehicles are equipped with snow plows and will be utilized for day-to-day maintenance operations.

Bidders were asked to include trade-in values for three District vehicles including a 2007 Chevrolet K3500 with 44,800 miles, a 2004 Chevrolet K3500 with 42,000 miles, and a 2011 Ford Escape with 71,500 miles. The trade-in allowances will be deducted from the bidder's base price.

Sealed bids were opened on Wednesday, August 1, 2018 and were evaluated to verify compliance with the specifications set forth in the Call to Bid. The lowest bid, submitted by Castle Chevrolet, meets all specifications. Their base bid of \$102,146, in addition to fee charges of \$290, less the trade-ins totaling \$16,000 resulted in a net bid of \$86,436. It is therefore recommended the bid be awarded to Castle Chevrolet, 175 N. Arlington Heights Road, Elk Grove Village, Illinois 60007.

RESOLUTION: APPROVAL OF READ FOR INFORMATION GRANT APPLICATION FOR GROVE JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL

<u>Background</u>

Sofia Huitron from Grove Junior High School, is requesting approval to apply for *The Read for Information Grant*. Funding for this grant is provided by the Library Book Selection Service (LBSS) Endowment Fund, which was established by The Illinois School Library Media Association now known as The Association of Illinois School Library Educators. *The Read for Information Grant* began awarding non-fiction materials to schools in 2012.

While building funds at our schools are used to help support the ongoing update of library collections, and both building and Title III funds have been used to support the addition of library books in Spanish as the dual language program transitioned to the junior high level, grants and donations provide an opportunity to boost collections more rapidly than is possible using only local or grant funds. This grant will support the purchase of non fiction books in Spanish in order to assist our school library in meeting Common Core expectations related to the balance of fiction and non fiction books. This grant will benefit the students in our dual language program. If approved, the grant award will be providing non fiction materials valued at not more than \$1,500.00.

Approval is recommended for the application of *The Read for Information Grant* for Grove Junior High School.


