Participant Eligibility

All registrations must be completed online. If you do not have access to Internet, a computer will be available in the **Athletic Office** for your use during school hours. **Master Card, Visa, and Debit cards can be used to pay for Summer Athletic Camps online only.** Any registrations paid by cash or check must be done in the **Athletic Office** during school hours of 7:30am - 3:00pm Mon - Fri.

Tuition Waivers

Fee waiver forms and registrations MUST be completed in the main or athletic office.

Refunds

Full refund of all fees if camp is cancelled. Other refunds will only be made because of serious illness and must be requested at the time of illness or injury and within the time the camp is being held. A doctor's note stating that the student is unable to participate is required. A cancellation fee of \$19.00 will be deducted from all refunds, and the remaining refund will be prorated based on the days the student attended camp. There are no refunds after half of the days of camp or for sessions canceled due to inclement weather.
