Committee Purpose: To discuss short and long-term financial projections.

- 1. Presentation by Forecast5 Analytics on 5Cast and 5Sight
 - Reviewed the overall structure of each budgeting program:
 - Allows for multiple users
 - Data is quickly accessible
 - Cost of the module and any annual fees
 - PMA hosts and supports the program
 - The 15/16 budget anticipated incorporation of the 5Cast/5Sight products

5Sight

- Uses publically shared information
- Saves time
- Eliminates having to find this information on the state website or by calling other districts
- o Pulls state financial information for school districts in a reportable format

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5Cast

- General Ledger
- A multi-year financial planning tool
- o Compares "what if" scenarios
- Helps districts be proactive v.s. reactive with information
- o Reportable Information specific to your district
- Direct export of data into your general ledger
- Much more efficient budget processes
- o Allows for versatility in building your projections and interactive graphs
 - Flexibility in models: monthly model, 5 yr, 10 yr, multiple scenarios
 - Downloadable
 - Reportable data in a user friendly format
- 2. Discussion of the Committee's Purpose and Scope
 - The committee will assist in making recommendations about budget tools and budget issues for the board to consider
- 3. Planning for Board of Education Financial Workshop (FUNancial Workshop)
 - Host a special meeting outside one of the normal board meetings

 - Tentatively schedule the workshop in November
 - Workshop Focus:
 - Acquire a more simple budgeting reporting tool that shows clearly what is happening to district finances:
 - Expenditures v.s. Revenues more clearly
 - Create a mid-year update as a follow up to the adopted budget
 - When would the purchase of a new financial reporting tool be actionable?
- 4. FY15 Budget how did we end up and why?
 - Reviewed budget variances of the last 5 years
- 5. Comparison To Fund Balance Policy and Ending Fund Balance Slide
 - Discussed reporting format of the Fund Balance to financial analysis more clearly
 - Effect of expenditures v.s. revenue
 - User friendliness of visual financial reporting tools
 - Is modification of the Fund Balance document needed
 - More in depth visual data to show the impact of:
 - Transfers
 - Bond revenue

- o Projections and assumptions
- 5. 2015 Tax Levy
 - Reviewed Tax Levy timeline
 - Allow time for the Levy process
 - Forecasts
 - Ruth did not forecast for under levying
 - Discussed permanent ramifications of under levying
