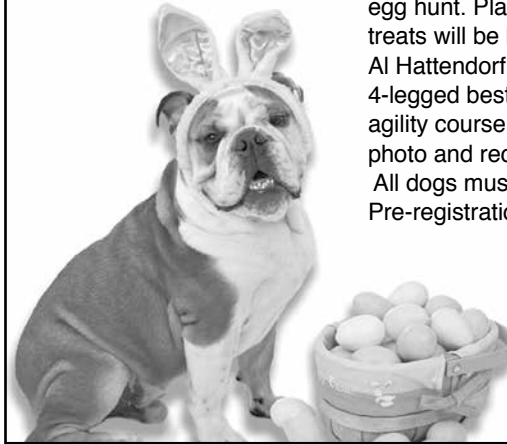
## DOGGY EGG HUNT
