 - i. The FY21 revenue and expense assumptions used to prepare the FY21 Tentative Budget were shared. Discussed the possibility of obtaining a line of credit in the event local tax revenue was delayed and additional revenue was needed to meet current expense obligations.
 - ii. The FY21 Tentative Budget report which will be presented to the Board of Education represents an almost \$1.7 million surplus.

 - 5. The first meeting of FY21 should be a joint meeting between the finance and facilities committees
