Youth Football & Cheerleading

Elk Grove Youth Football's goal is to develop player's skills while having fun playing football. Tackle teams are players 8 through 14 year olds and are structured based on age and weight. Flag teams are for 5 through 7 year olds and does have a weight restriction.

Practices are in the evenings 6 to 8 pm and games are held on Saturday or Sunday at various times. Elk Grove Youth Football is a proud member of Bill George Youth Football League. Football fitting day on Saturday, May 15th at the Pavilion.

Eagles Cheer is a 100% volunteer organization that provides cheerleaders with the opportunity to learn fundamental cheerleading and stunting skills with an emphasis on sportsmanship, teamwork and safety.

Flag Cheer – (entering) Kindergarten and 1st Grade: Flag cheerleaders will cheer on the sidelines for Eagles flag football teams and perform short halftime routines. Practices will be one day a week and games are held on Saturday or Sunday. Season runs from beginning of August through Mid-November.

Competition and Sideline Cheer – (entering) 2nd through 8th grade: Cheerleaders will support our Eagle football teams by cheering on the sidelines and performing short halftime routines at home and away football games. Cheerleaders will also compete in 2 to 4 IRCA cheer competitions, depending on grade level of squad. (Up to 3 consecutive grade levels may be combined to form squads). All competitions are held in Illinois. Practices will be a *minimum* of 2 days a week. Cheer season runs from beginning of August through IRCA State Competition weekend in December.

Kids Club After School Program

With CCSD59 announcement for hybrid learning beginning March 29, the Elk Grove Park District will offer after school programming that will follow the CCSD59 calendar for in-person learning, Monday-Tuesday and Thursday-Friday. Held in a safe, supervised environment, Kids' Club After School program operates out of Byrd, Clearmont, Ridge, Rupley and Salt Creek. Our After School program begins at school dismissal and runs through 6pm. Activities include arts & crafts, games, outdoor play and much more! *Note: If registrations are low at site, we will provide transportation from your child's school and bus them to Ridge.

PM Care: 3-6pm- \$12 per day (Byrd, Clearmont, Rupley, Salt Creek) PM Care Ridge: 2-6pm- \$16 per day

Parents are able to customize the program based on their family's needs by registering for after school designating which days are needed each week. Registration must be in person for the Kids' Club Hybrid After School Program. All programs are contingent on meeting the minimum registrations numbers.
