<u>Background:</u> The Administration has completed our 2021.22 Return to School Plan in alignment with the most current guidance from the Center for Disease Control (CDC), the Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH), the Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE), and the Cook County Department of Public Health (CCDPH). As was the case previously, the approval of the plan by the Board of Education authorizes the Administration to implement and enforce compliance with the 2021.22 Return to School Plan.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of Community Consolidated School District No. 59, Cook County, Illinois, as follows with respect to the opening and operation of the District's offices, facilities, programs and schools for the 2021-22 school year:

- 1. The plan for the opening and operation of the District's offices, facilities, programs and schools for the 2021-22 school year, substantially in the form presented by the Superintendent and entitled "2021.22 Return to School Plan" and dated August 2, 2021, is hereby approved.
- 2. The Superintendent and the Superintendent's designees are hereby authorized and directed to implement and enforce the Plan and are further authorized to require students, staff, parents, visitors and other participants in the District's programs to comply with the Plan and with the directives of the Superintendent and the Superintendent's designees implementing and enforcing the Plan.
- 3. The Superintendent is hereby authorized to modify the Plan from time to time to conform to the requirements of, or guidance from, any entity with authority over the District, including, but not limited to, the Governor of Illinois, the Illinois Department of Public Health, the Illinois State Board of Education, the Illinois High School Association, and the Cook County Department of Public

Health, and as otherwise appropriate to facilitate the operation of the schools and the safety of students, staff, visitors and other participants in the District's programs. Any substantive changes to the Plan shall be made in consultation with the President of the Board and then promptly reported to the Board which may affirm, modify or disapprove of the changes. The changes shall, however, remain in full force and effect until such time as the Board acts, unless otherwise required by law.

- 4. This Resolution, and the Plan as may be modified from time to time pursuant to number 3 above, are adopted, and are to be implemented and enforced, in the exercise of the discretionary powers granted to the Board by Sections 10-20 and 10-20.5 of the Illinois School Code and any other applicable law. The Plan constitutes rules adopted by the Board pursuant to Section 10-20.5 of the School Code which shall be filed in the District's central administrative office and posted on the District's website. In accordance with Board Policy 4.180 Pandemic Preparedness, the Plan, and the authority granted to the Superintendent and the Superintendent's designees by this Resolution, supersede any policy or other rule of the Board to the extent any such policy or rule is inconsistent with the Plan.
 - 5. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon adoption.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT on the 2nd day of August 2021, the Community Consolidated School District 59 Board of Education hereby approves the 2021.22 Return to School Plan & COVID-19 Board Policy.

The 2021/22 Tentative Budget has been on public display since July 1st at both the District Administration Building and on the District's website. An announcement regarding the August 2nd public hearing appeared in the local newspaper in accordance with the Illinois School Code. The process of adoption includes a review of recommended changes to the budget, a public hearing, and the final adoption. The adopted budget must be submitted to the State Board of Education.

As is customary, refinements are made to the Tentative Budget based on various developments and data that were unknown during the preparation phase. While every effort was made to budget for all known programs and plans, the following factors caused changes to the Final Budget:

- Potential Facility Maintenance and Upgrades
- Holmes flooding and insurance



RESOLUTION: RECOMMENDATION FOR CHANGES TO THE 2021/22 TENTATIVE BUDGET

Background

On June 7, 2021 the Board discussed the 2021/22 tentative budget and the Board of Education approved a resolution instructing the administration to publicly display the 2021/22 tentative budget and place a notice in the newspaper concerning the hearing of the final budget on August 2, 2021.

As is customary, refinements are made to the tentative budget based on various developments and data which were unknown. When the data became available it was incorporated into the budget. Changes have been summarized via a separate memorandum and listing, identified by the individual funds.
