As our district continues forward on our equity journey, our focus remains to ensure all students have equitable access to both tools and opportunities in order to equip them to be successful for life.

Based on the results of our Equity Audit, this school year we have focused on three specific action steps and what the outcomes of addressing these areas will mean for our students, families, and staff. The three areas of progress we are proud to celebrate for this year are as follows:

## **Updated Elementary and Junior High Schedules**

As we evaluated our daily schedules at all grade levels, we found there were several important areas for improvement. These areas include: inequitable opportunities for students, non-compliance issues due to the structure of the schedules, inconsistent instructional minutes, and a lack of dedicated time for interventions and extensions (WIN).

At the board of education meeting on April 11, we presented our new schedule structures and shared the following highlights:

- Elementary students will now meet the requirement of having PE three times a week
- Elementary students will have art and music instruction every week • Elementary schedules will provide increased daily staff collaboration time for
- grade level teams and colleagues
- Junior High students will have increased opportunities for What I Need (WIN) time to individualize instruction
- Junior High students will have expanded instructional time
- Junior High schedules will have increased consistency across the three junior high buildings

## **Elimination of Multi-Grade Classrooms** Due to a variety of enrollment factors, multi-grade elementary classrooms have

been in place across the district over the past several years. These classrooms have students from two different grade levels as a way to alleviate class size issues in certain grade level sections. The multi-grade classroom as it is currently structured is not an ideal solution for either students or staff, and we committed to resolving the issue by eliminating all multi-grade classes for next school year.
