RESOLUTION: APPROVE PORTABLE CLASSROOMS FOR BRENTWOOD AND FROST ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS

Background

The district is in need of two portable units; one at Brentwood Elementary School and the second at Frost Elementary School. There are several reasons for this:

- 1. Programming is shifting to these buildings, resulting in an immediate need for classroom space that does not exist.
- 2. Space is at a premium for both campuses.
- 3. The district is in the process of evaluating long-term solutions for equity around all buildings. This is a temporary solution. We anticipate using these at these two locations for one year during 2022-2023.

Each portable unit contains two classrooms and one washroom. The rationale behind the washroom is due to safety, students should not travel between these exterior classrooms and the building. There were not many options due to portables not adhering to current health life safety laws, as well as the lack of cleanliness and disrepair.

Each portable unit is approximately \$220,000. It would be a rent-to-own contract with a buyout of \$1 at the end of the lease. Facilities and Operations is confident these units can be sold or reused if needed at buildings in following years.

The cost to run electricity to both mobile units is \$164,300. The cost to run water is \$55,000 for both mobile units. This brings the total cost to approximately \$659,300 for both units at the two schools for one school year.

The price for any expansion, additions or classroom reconfiguration outweighs a temporary situation. Therefore, it is recommended that the district invest in portable classrooms.
