Approval of Portable Classrooms for Brentwood and Frost Elementary Schools

The district recently evaluated classroom availability and needs across school buildings. The need for additional space was identified at Brentwood and Frost Elementary Schools, and since this classroom space is not currently available, the temporary solution of portable classrooms was previously discussed at the board meeting on May 9, 2022. The portable classrooms would be utilized at the two locations for one year during the 2022-23 school year.

Each portable unit contains two classrooms and one washroom so that students do not need to travel between these exterior classrooms and the building. Each portable unit is approximately \$220,000 and would be a rent-to-own contract with a buyout of \$1 at the end of the lease.

With the required utilities, the total cost is approximately \$659,300 for both units at the two schools for one school year.

After additional discussion, the board voted and approved the purchase of two portable classrooms as outlined above.
