### **DEMOGRAPHICS**

The district has school demographics ranging from 14% to 71% for Hispanic students and 11% to 78% for White students, the district's largest two race/ethnic groups. The district also has a range of 29% to 66% for families who qualify for free and reduced lunch.



### **ENROLLMENT**

The district target is to maintain a minimum of 300 students per elementary school to achieve equitable programming and sustainability. The district currently has five schools below the 300 student target.

#### RESOURCE ALLOCATION

The district has school per pupil operating expenses ranging from \$13,968 to \$19,732.

#### STUDENT OUTCOMES

The district has a range of school spring growth goal averages of 48% to 87% in math and 52% to 89% in reading based on the iReady assessment.



#### **CLASS SIZES**

The district has class sizes ranging from 9 students to 32 students.

#### **TRANSPORTATION**

The district has student bus travel times ranging from 16 minutes to 66 minutes each way.

### **ACCESS TO PROGRAMMING**

The district does not offer all available programs at all of our schools. Programs include, but are not limited to multilingual services, special education, and early learning.



#### FACILITY CAPACITY AND USAGE

The district varies in student enrollment ranging from 41% to 95% of each school's total building capacity.











AREAS IN GRAY INDICATE NON-RESIDENTIAL AREAS WITHIN THE DISTRICT.
