In 2012, the Village adopted a Bicycle Plan to create a safe, comfortable and bicycle-friendly environment in Mount Prospect, which encourages people of all ages to use bicycles for everyday transportation and enjoyment. Since then, the Village has installed 28 miles of on-street bike routes! We are now moving to the next phase of the Bicycle Plan, developing a strategy to construct bike facilities along arterial and other high traffic streets to create a complete bicycle network in the Village.

Come to the Community Open House to provide your input on where bicycle facilities should be located, and what improvements should be made to ensure safe access and connectivity for people biking and walking. There will not be a formal presentation, so feel free to stop by at any time.
