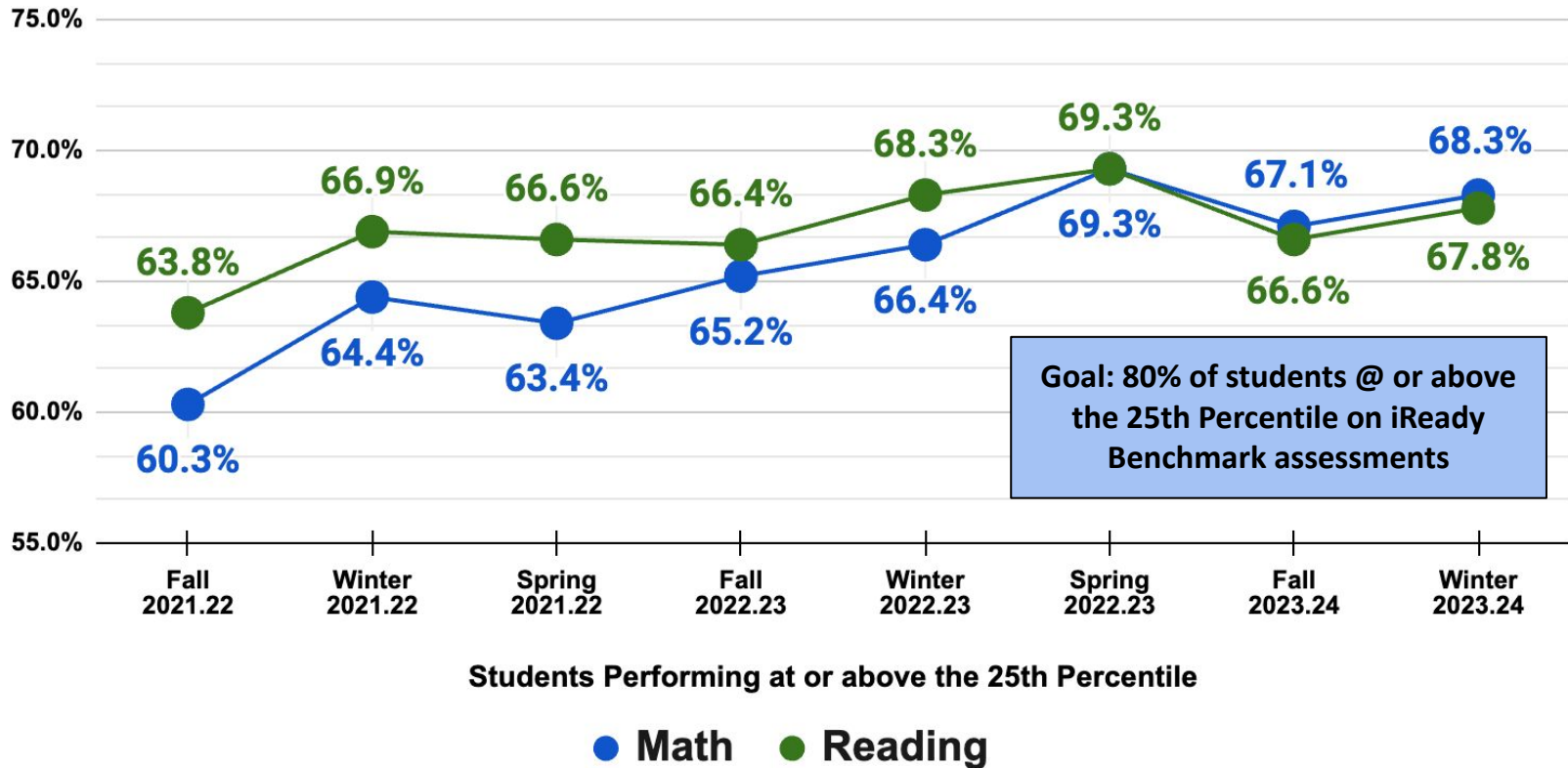

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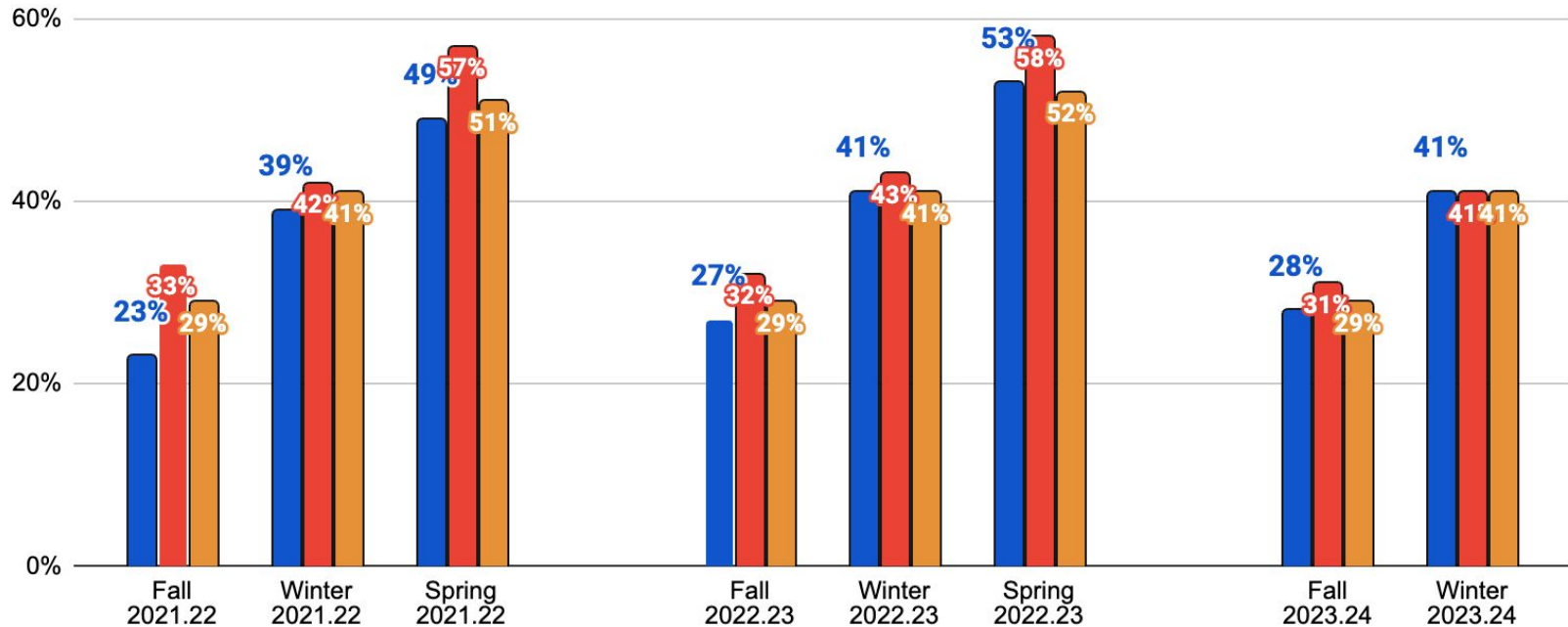

i-Ready Reading Proficiency Results Fall 2021 thru Winter 2024



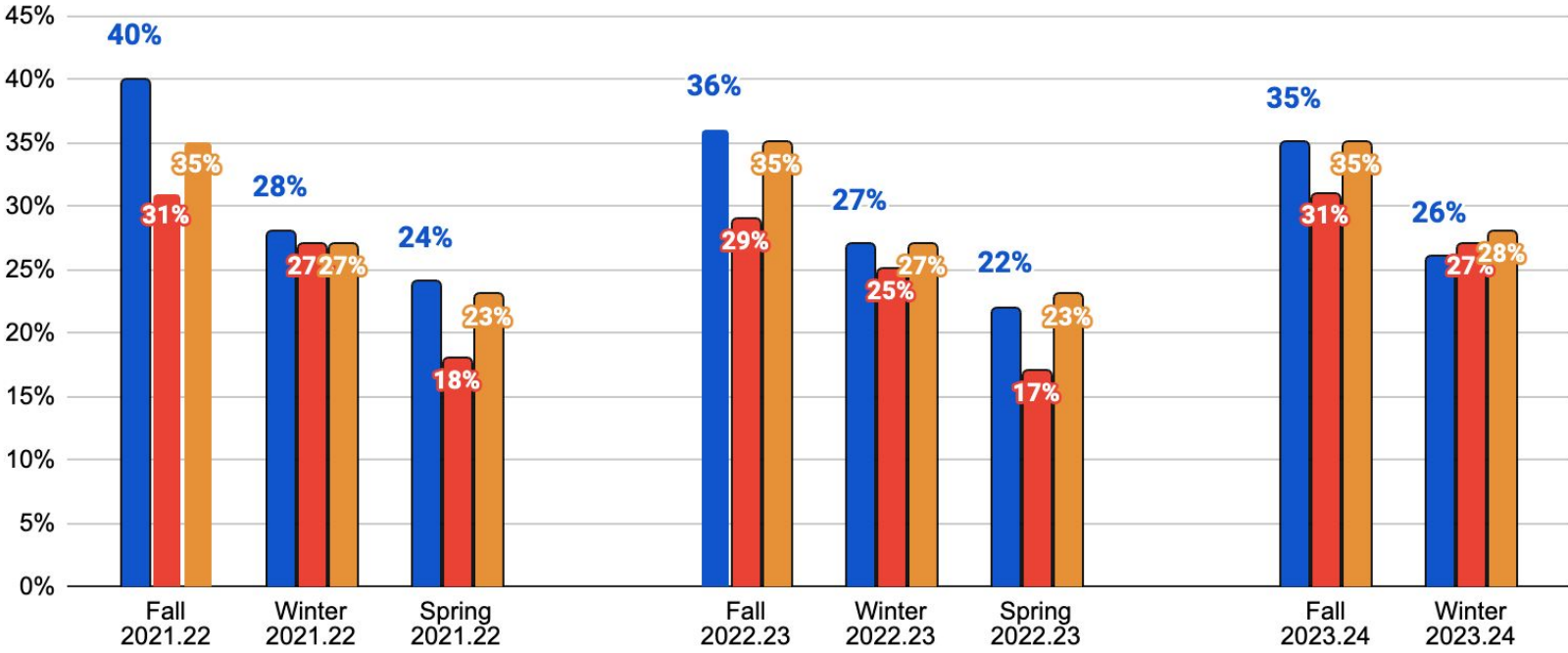

i-Ready Reading 2 & 3+ Years Below Grade Level Results Fall 2021 thru Winter 2024



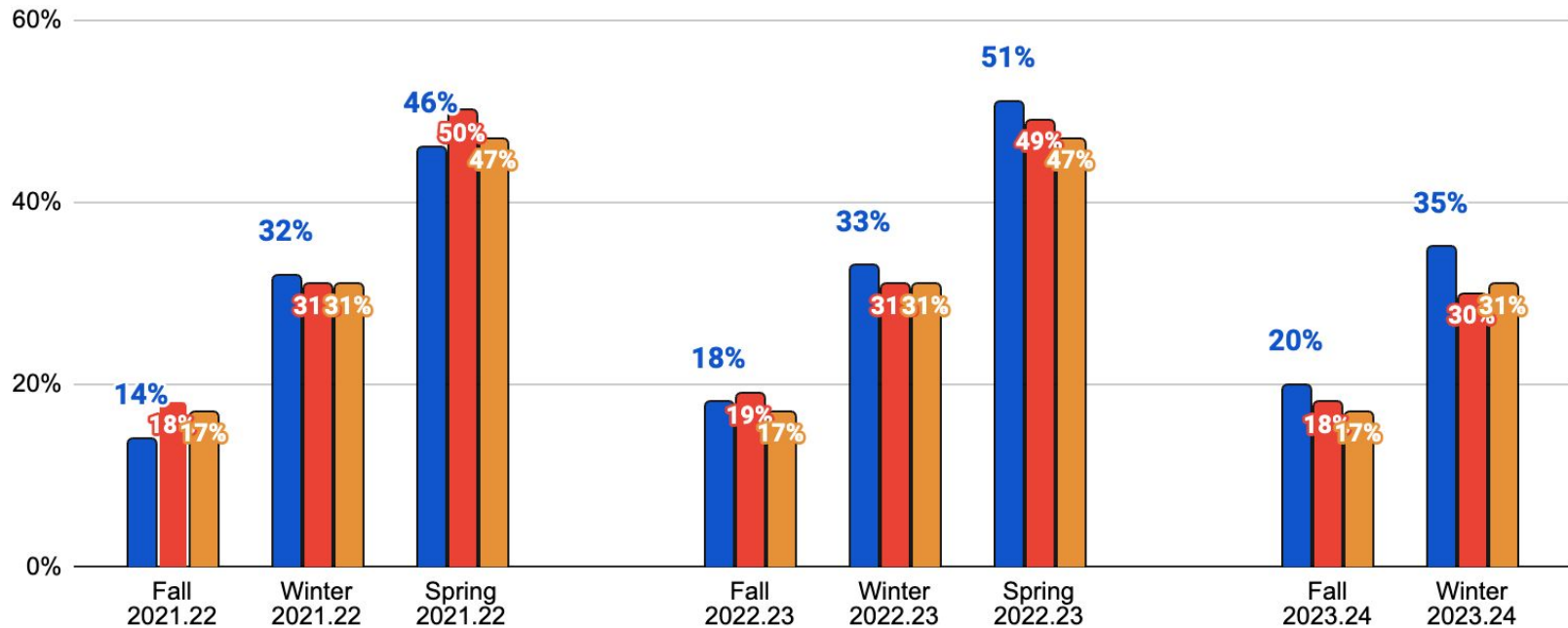

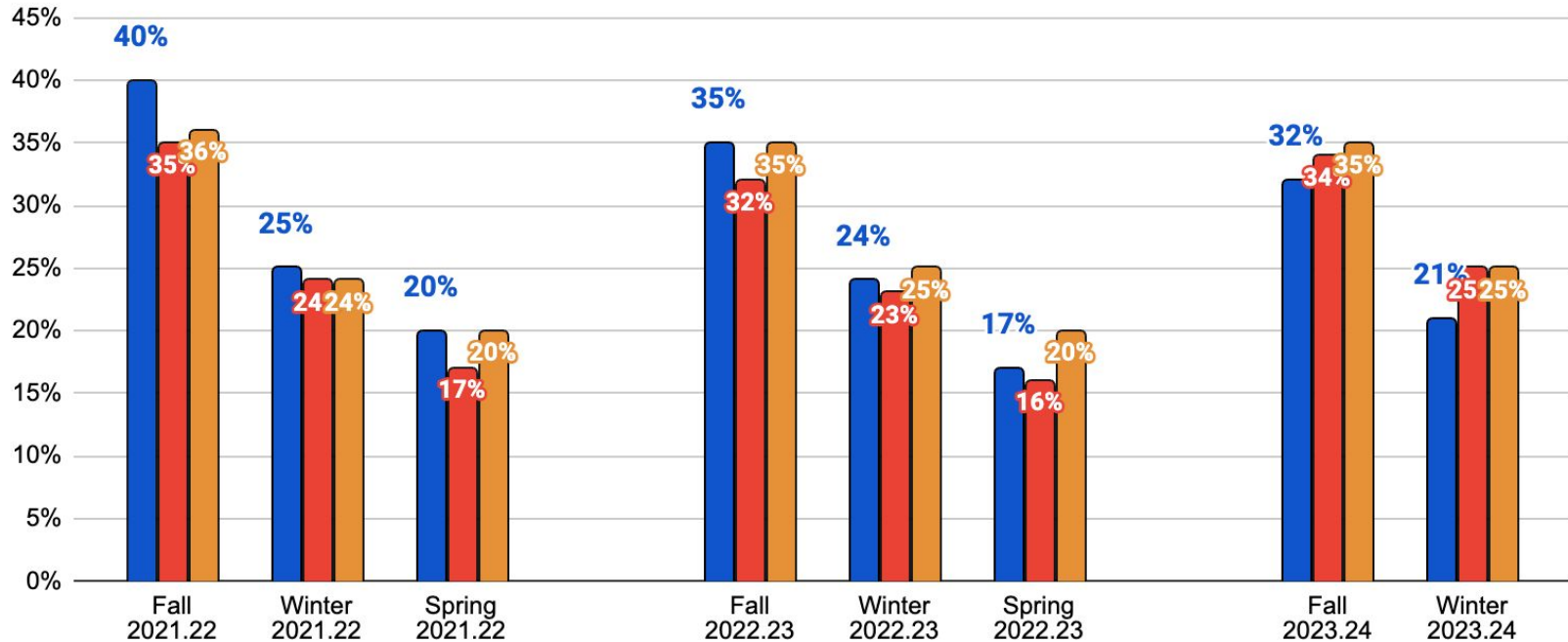

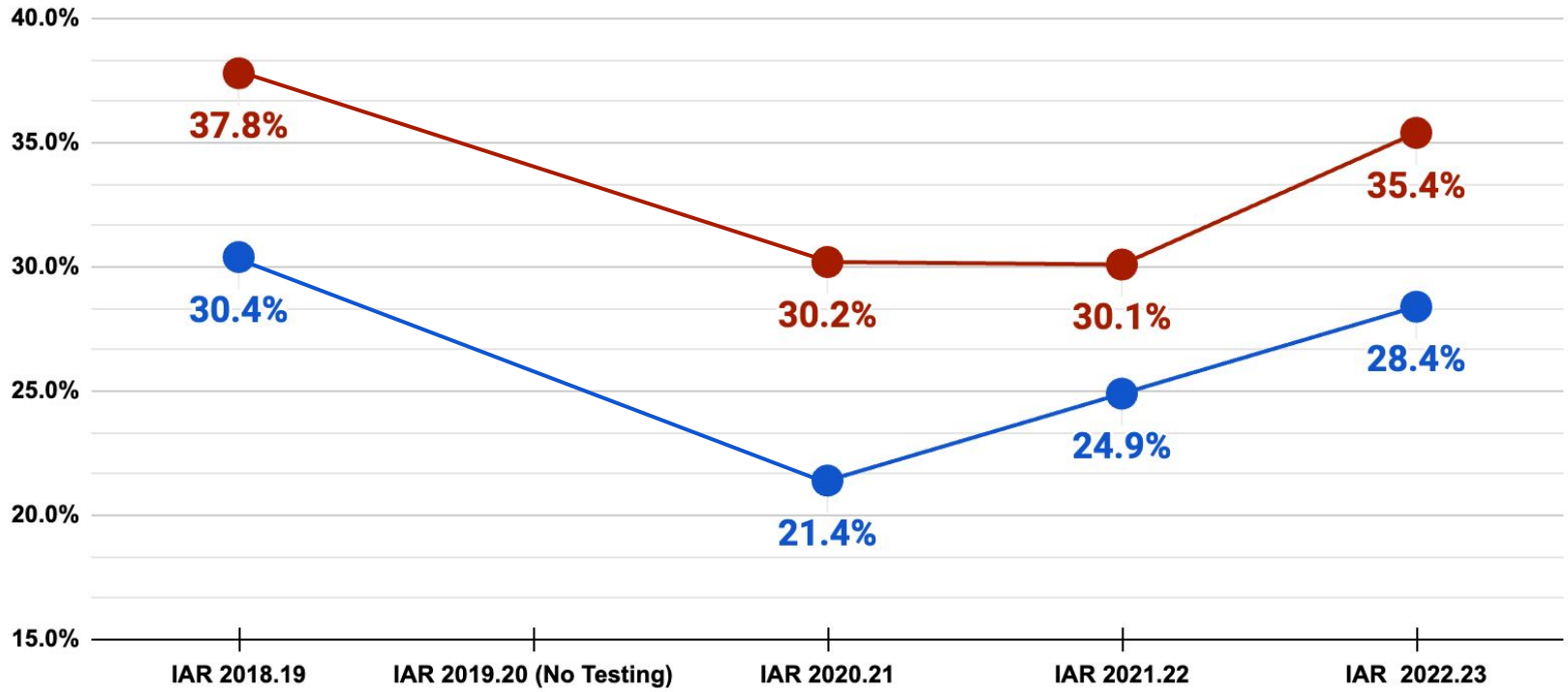

ILLINOIS ASSESSMENT OF READINESS (IAR) READING & MATH RESULTS



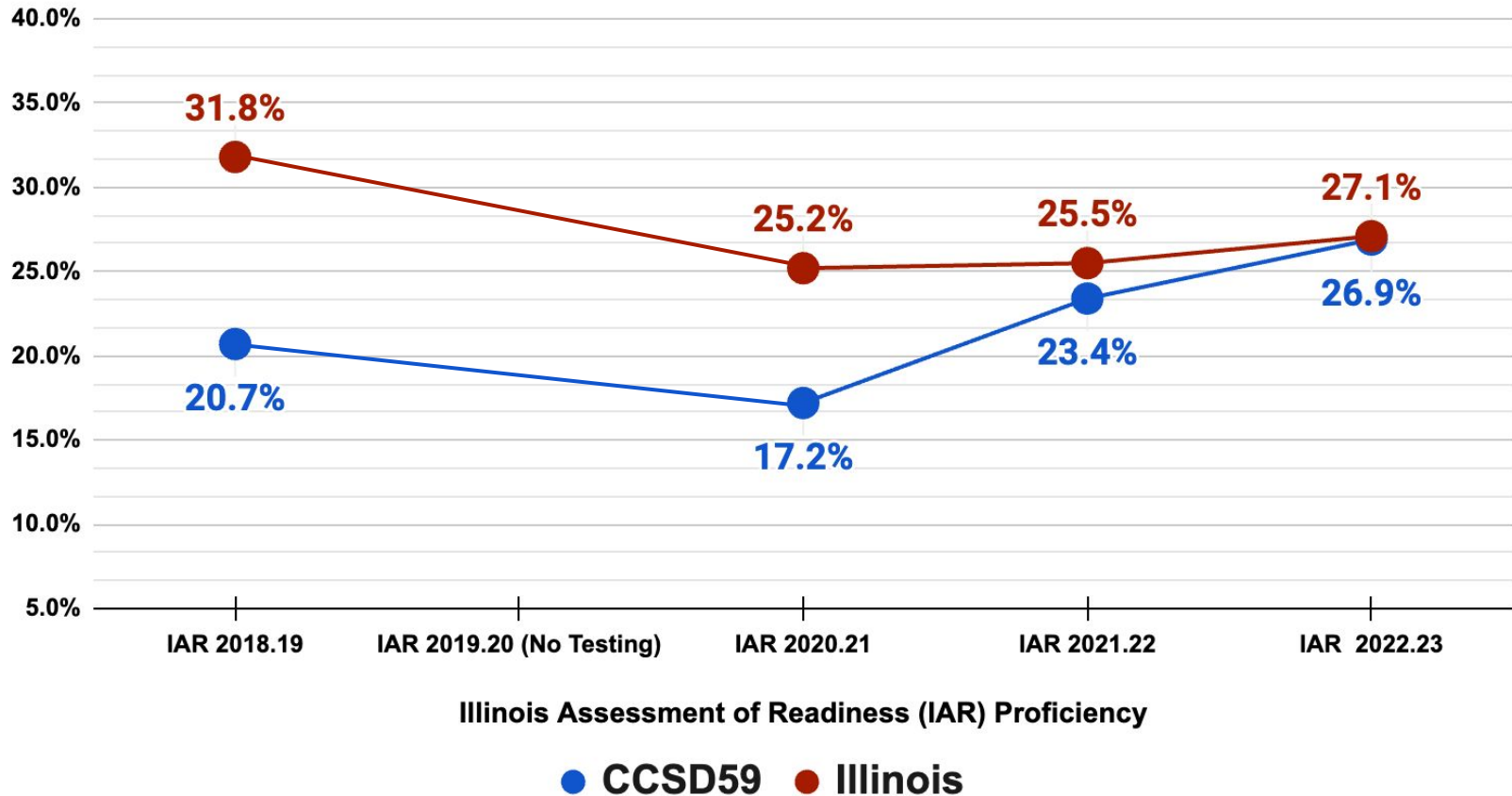
IAR Reading Results 2018.19 thru 2022.23



Illinois Assessment of Readiness (IAR) Proficiency

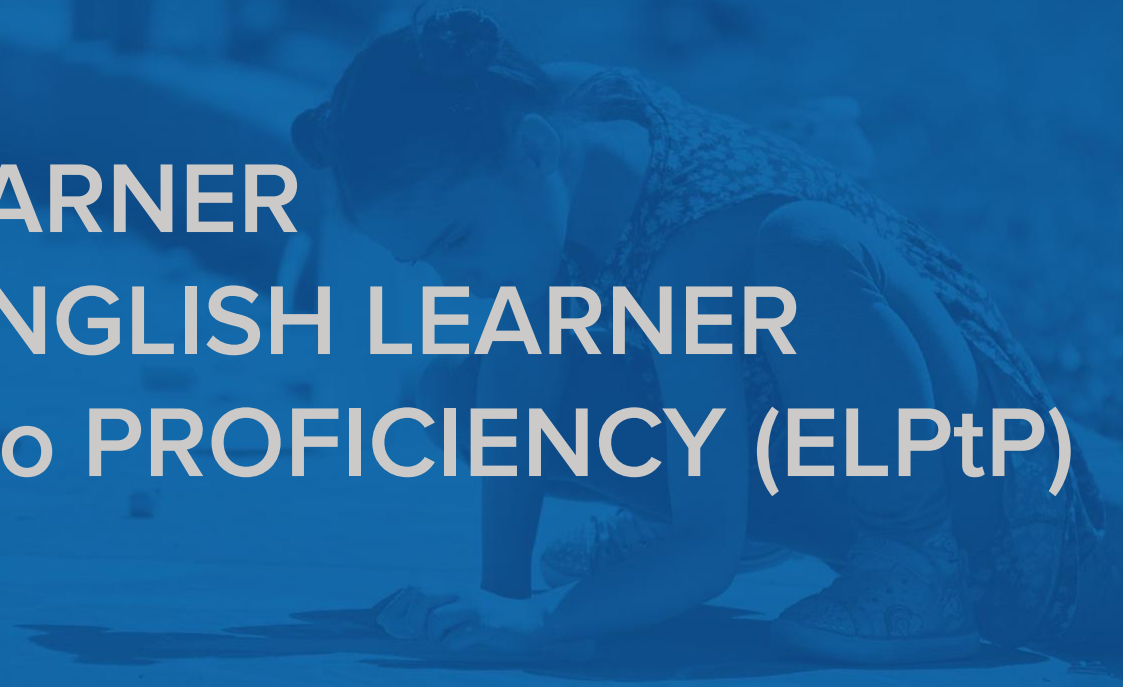

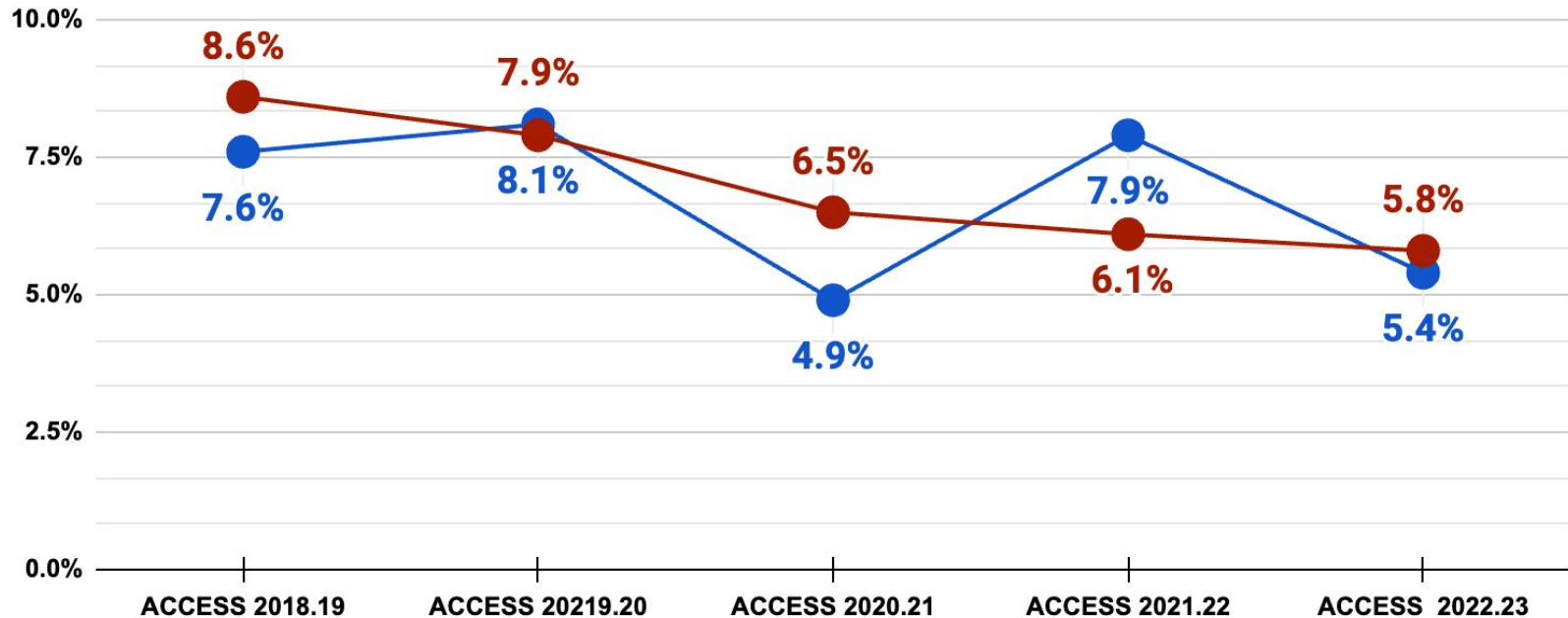




ENGLISH LEARNER ACCESS & ENGLISH LEARNER PROGRESS to PROFICIENCY (ELPtP) RESULTS



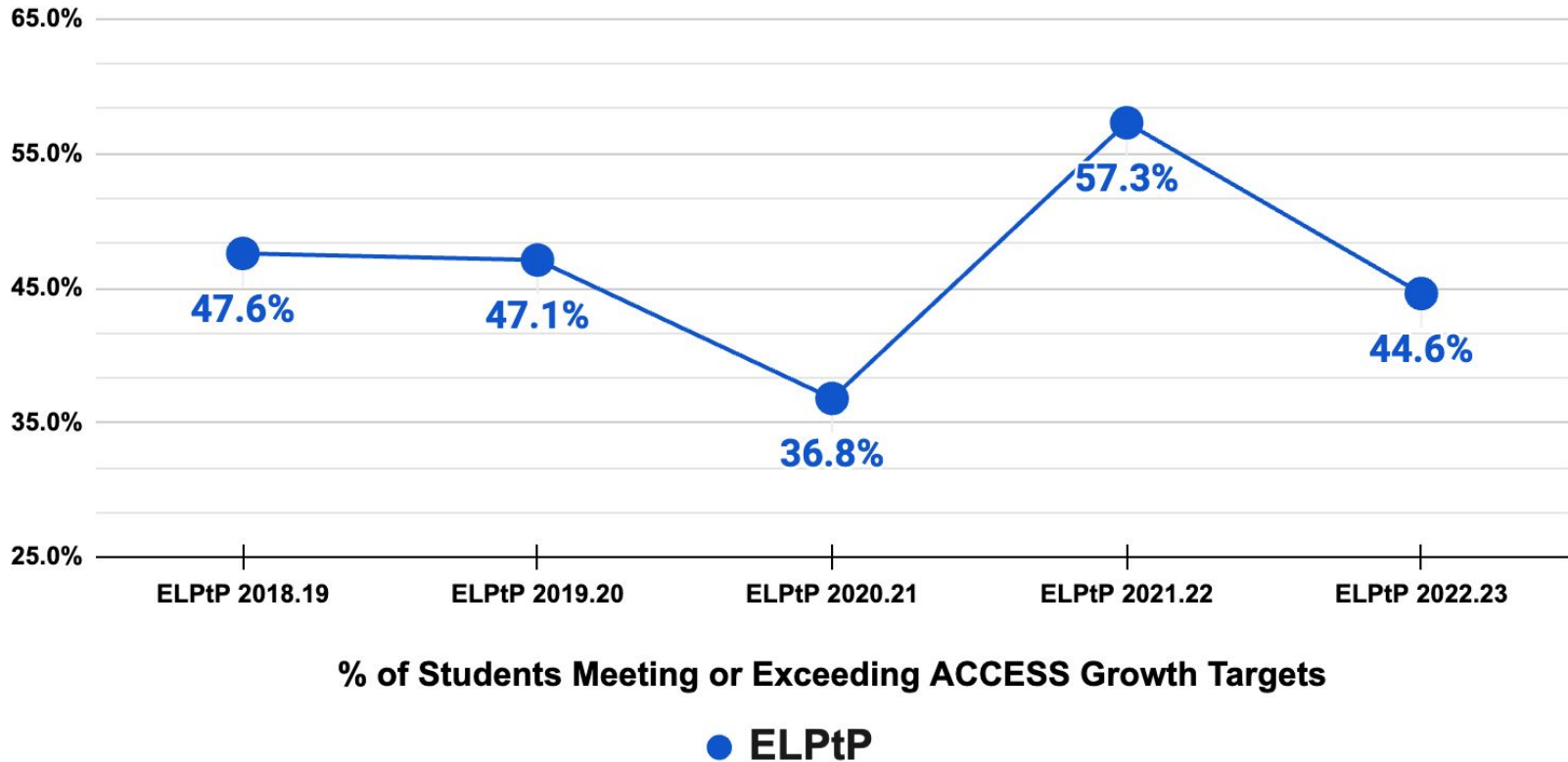

English Learner Progress to Proficiency (ELPtP) Results 2018.19 - 2022.23

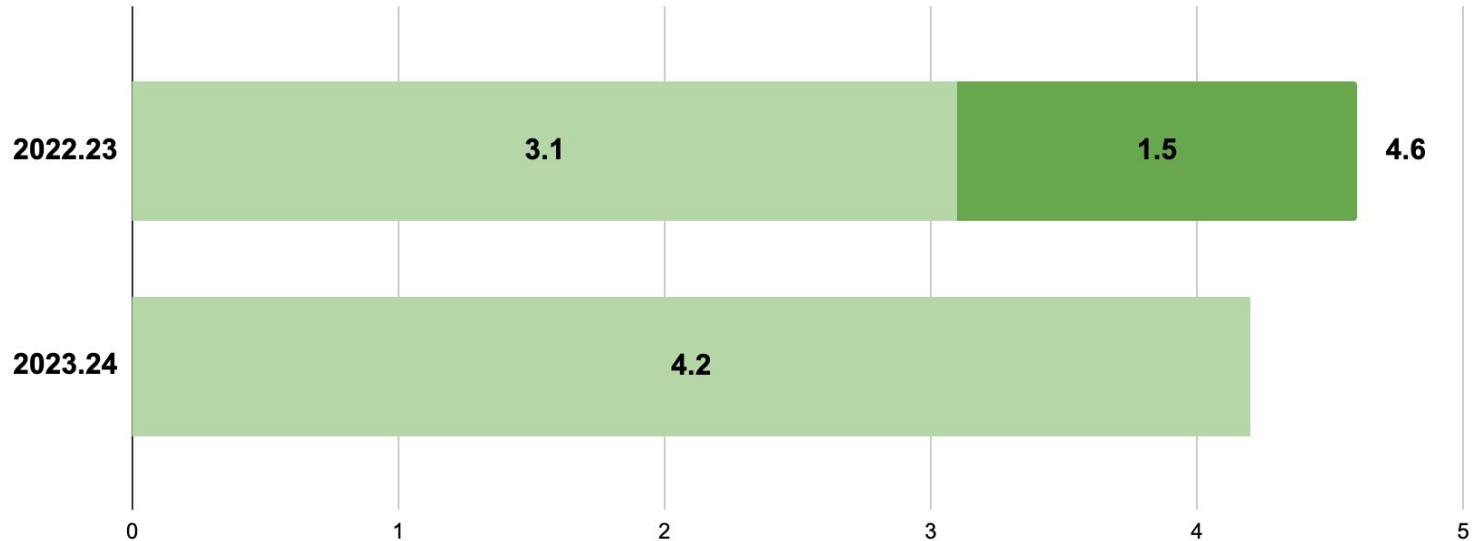

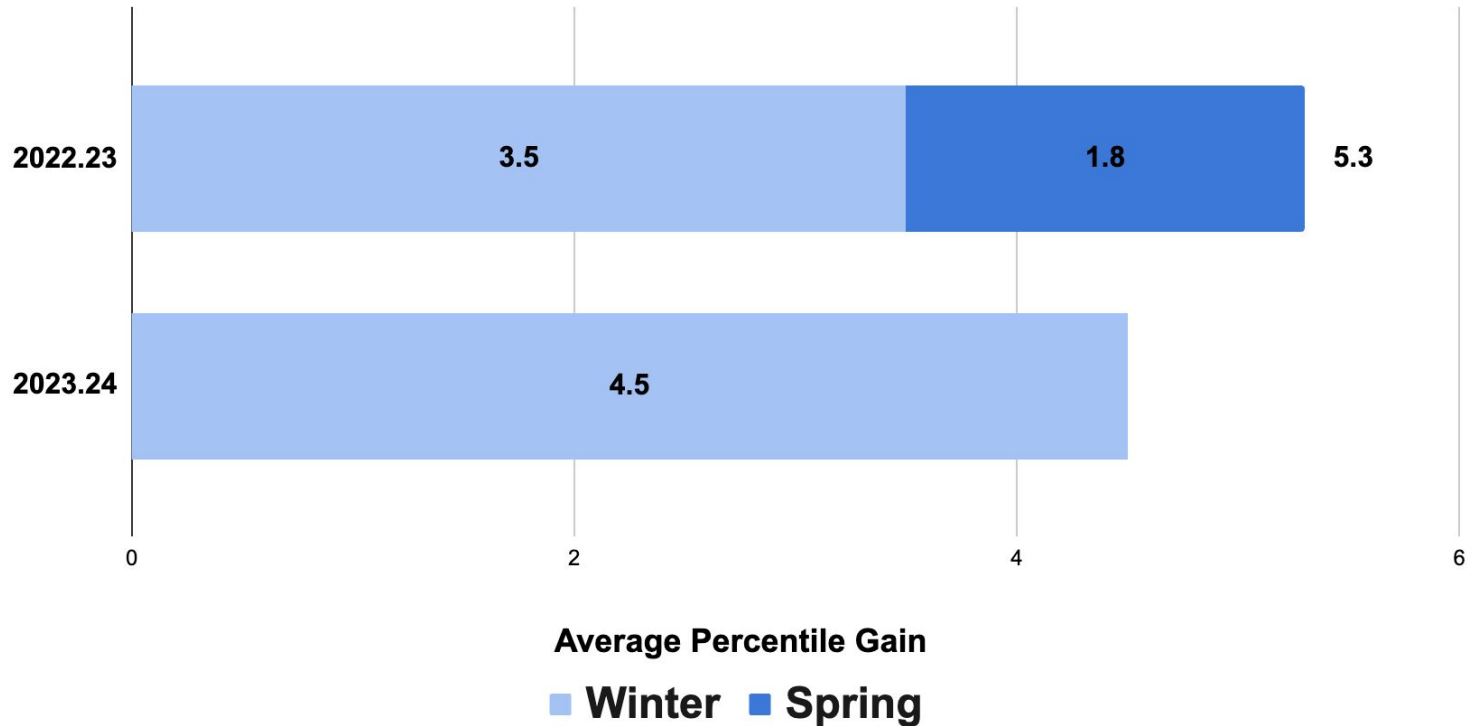
Reading Intervention Growth Rates Fall 2022 thru Winter 2024



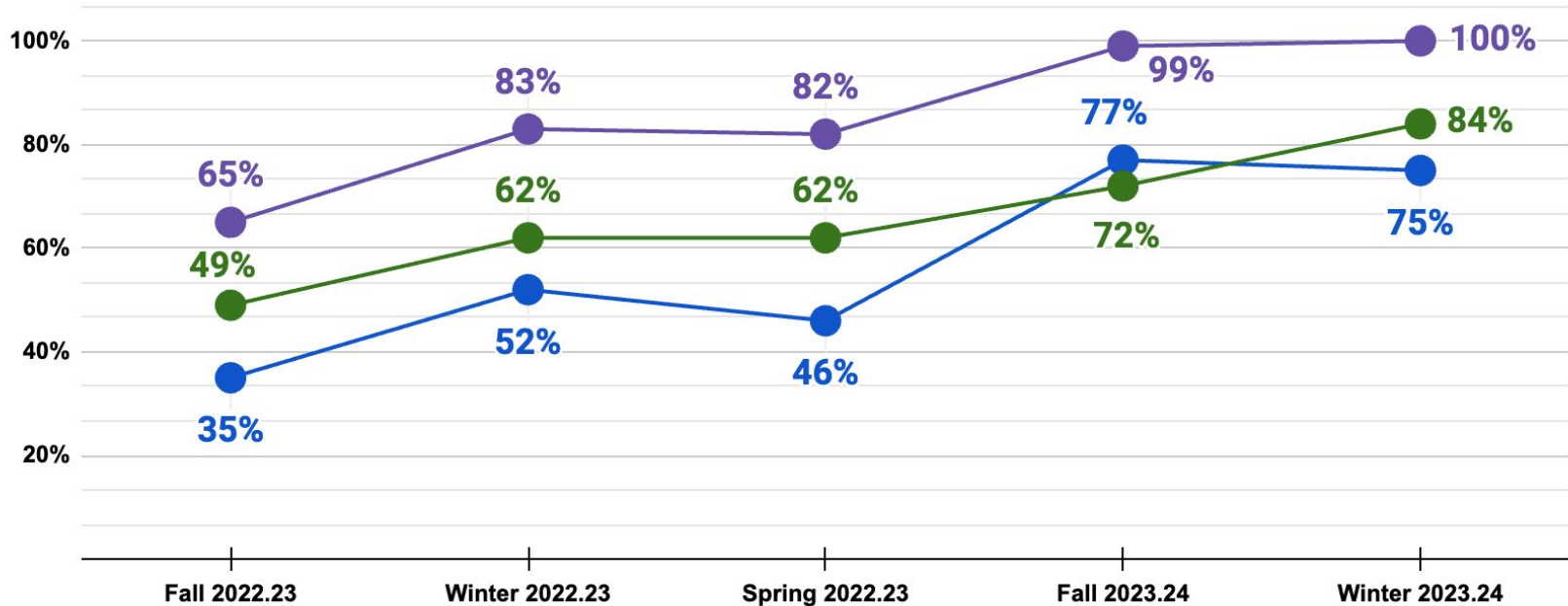
Average Percentile Gain

Provision Rate = The Percent of Students who Qualify for an Intervention Plan, who are Receiving Intervention

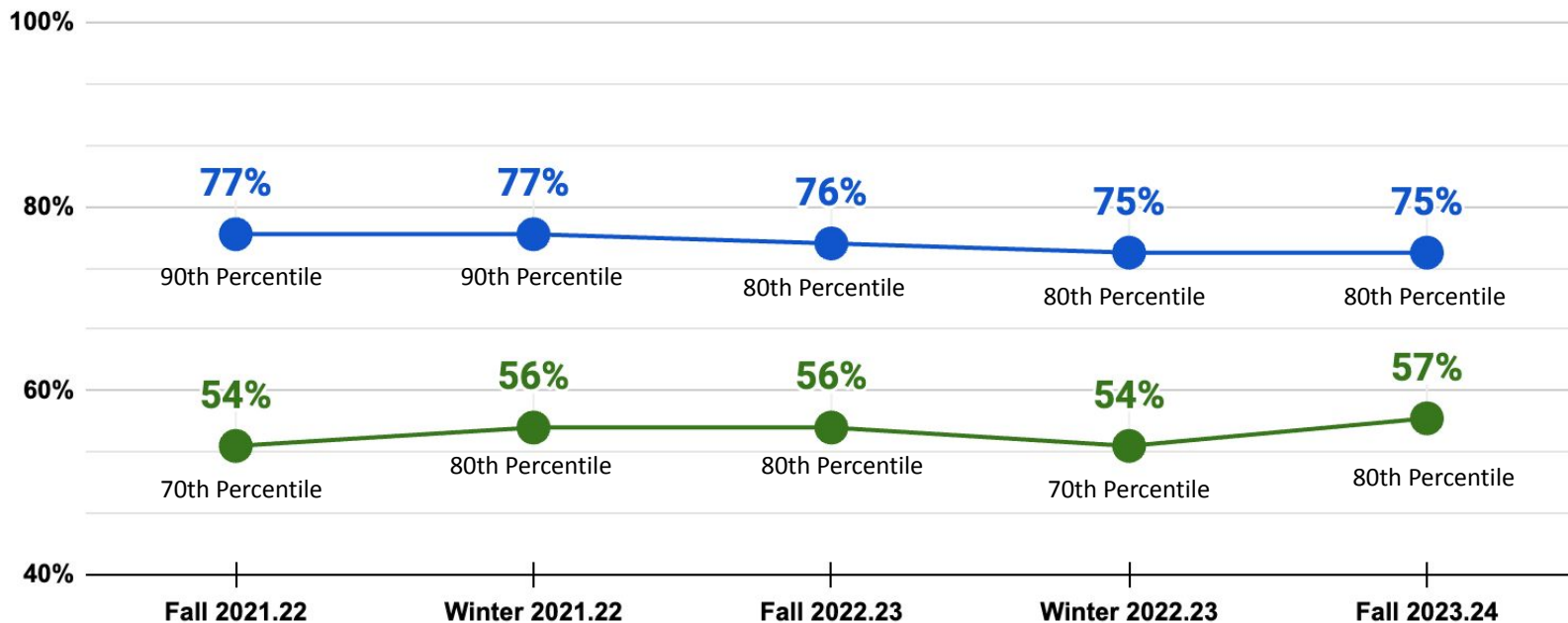

EDUCATION RECOVERY SCORECARD OVERVIEW

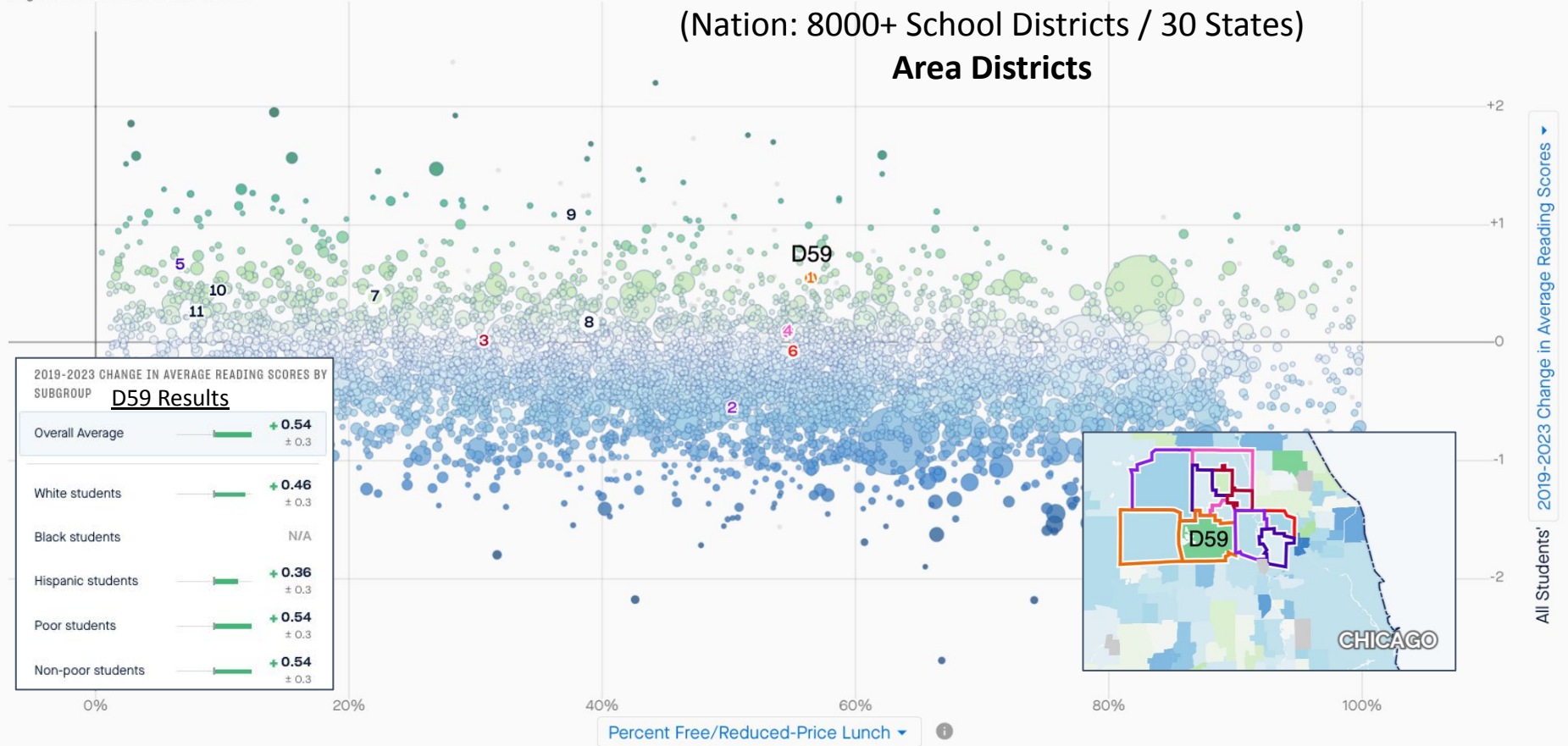
The *2019-2023 Education Recovery Scorecard* (ERS) compares “learning loss and ensuing recovery” using pre-pandemic (2018.19 school year) state assessment reading and math results for grades 3 - 8 to the results from the 2022.23 school year. The current ERS database includes over 8,000 school districts from 30 states and was developed through a collaboration between the Education Opportunity Project @ Stanford University, the Center for Educational Policy Research @ Harvard University, and the Stanford Center for Education Policy Analysis.

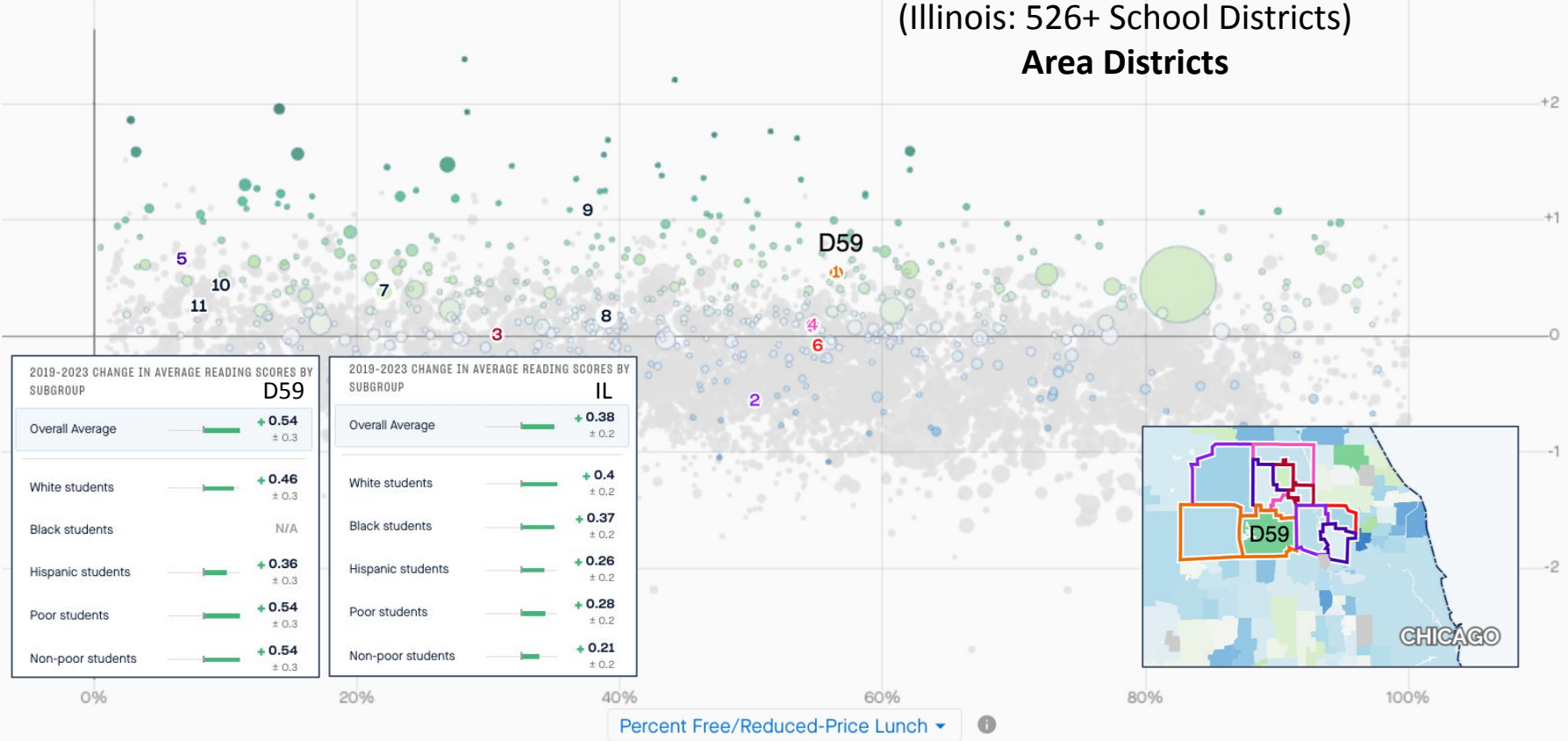

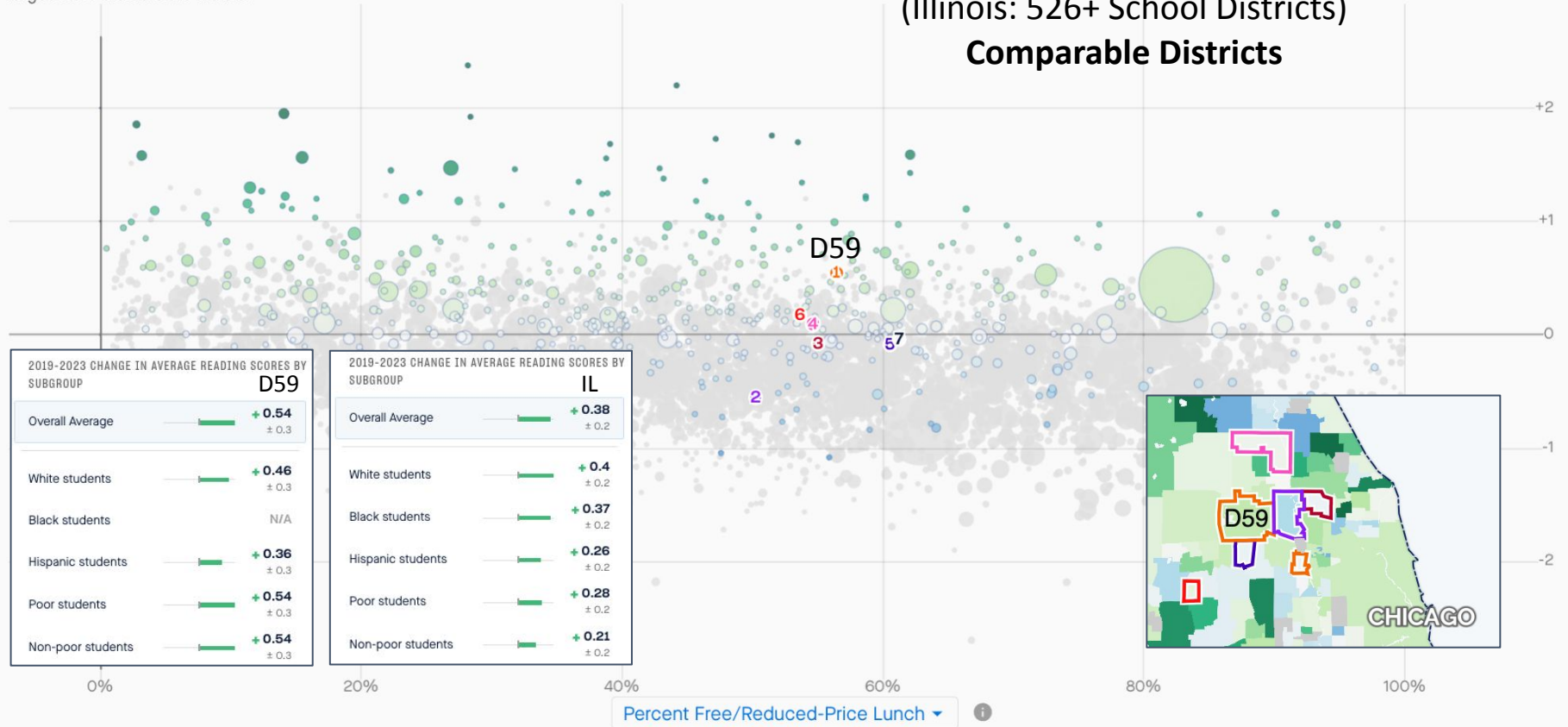


All Students' 2019-2023 Change in Average Reading Scores ▾

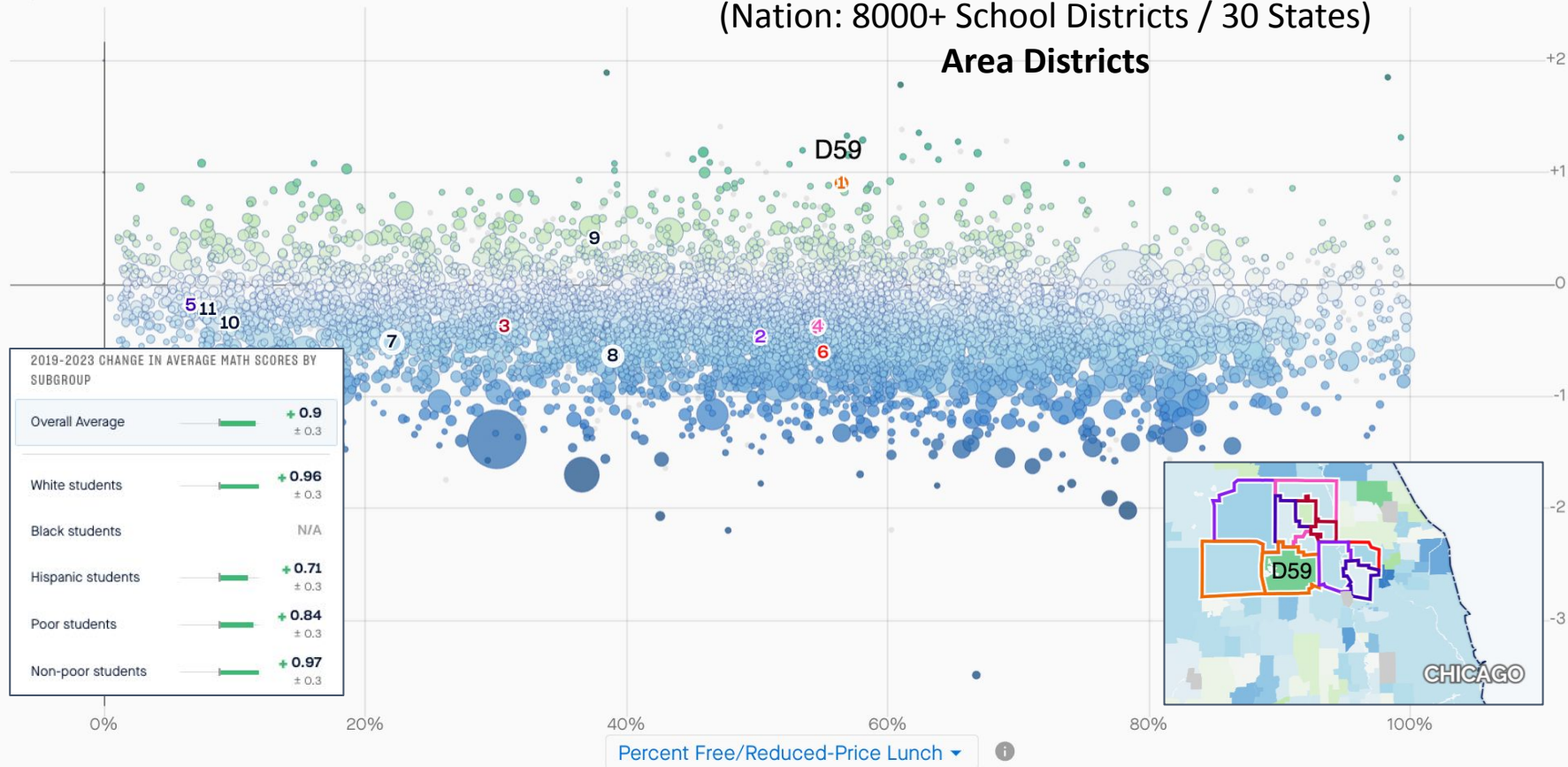

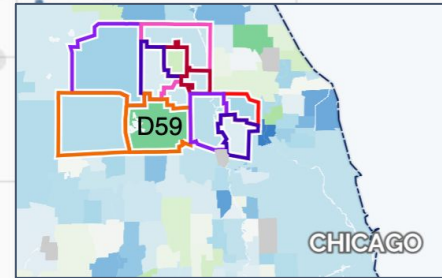
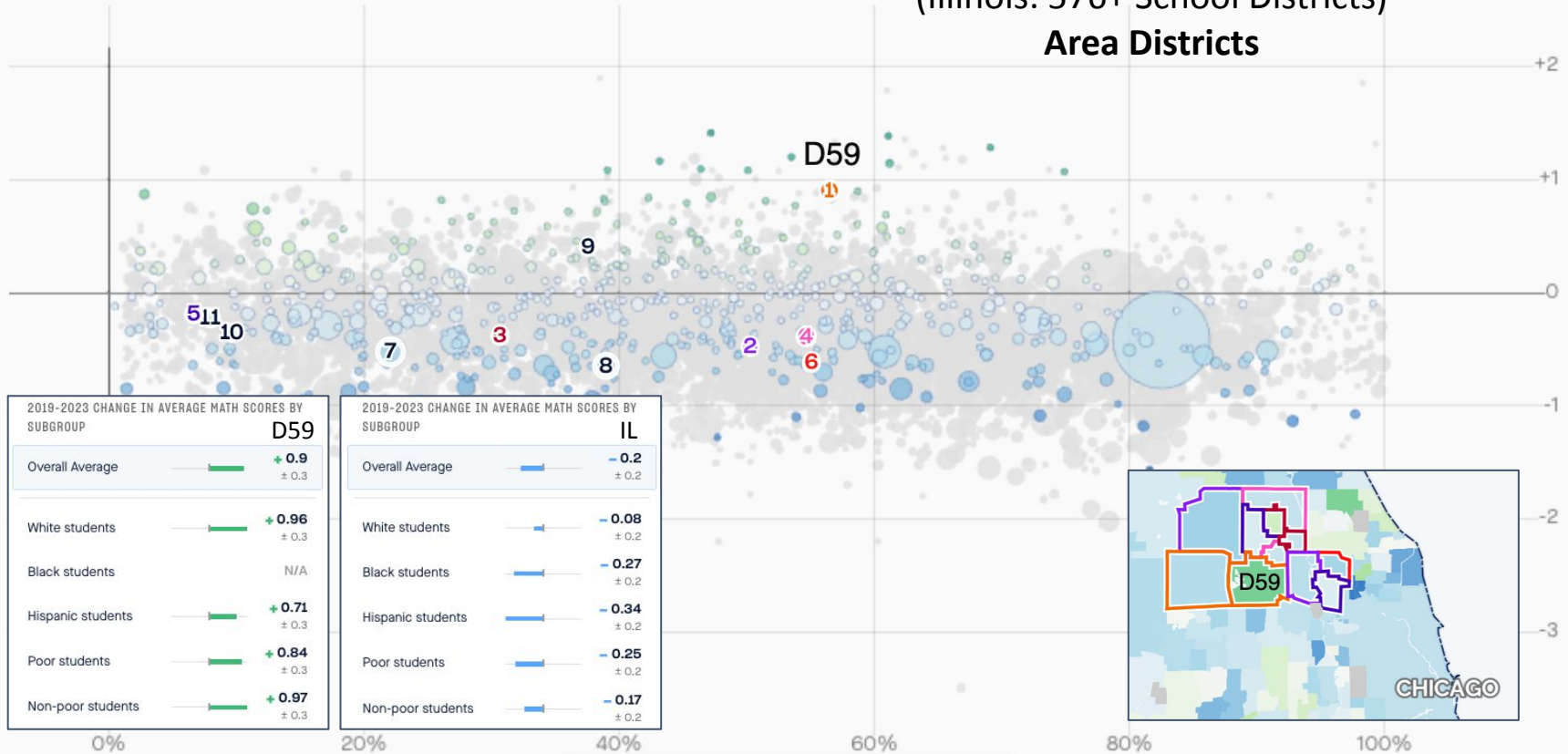

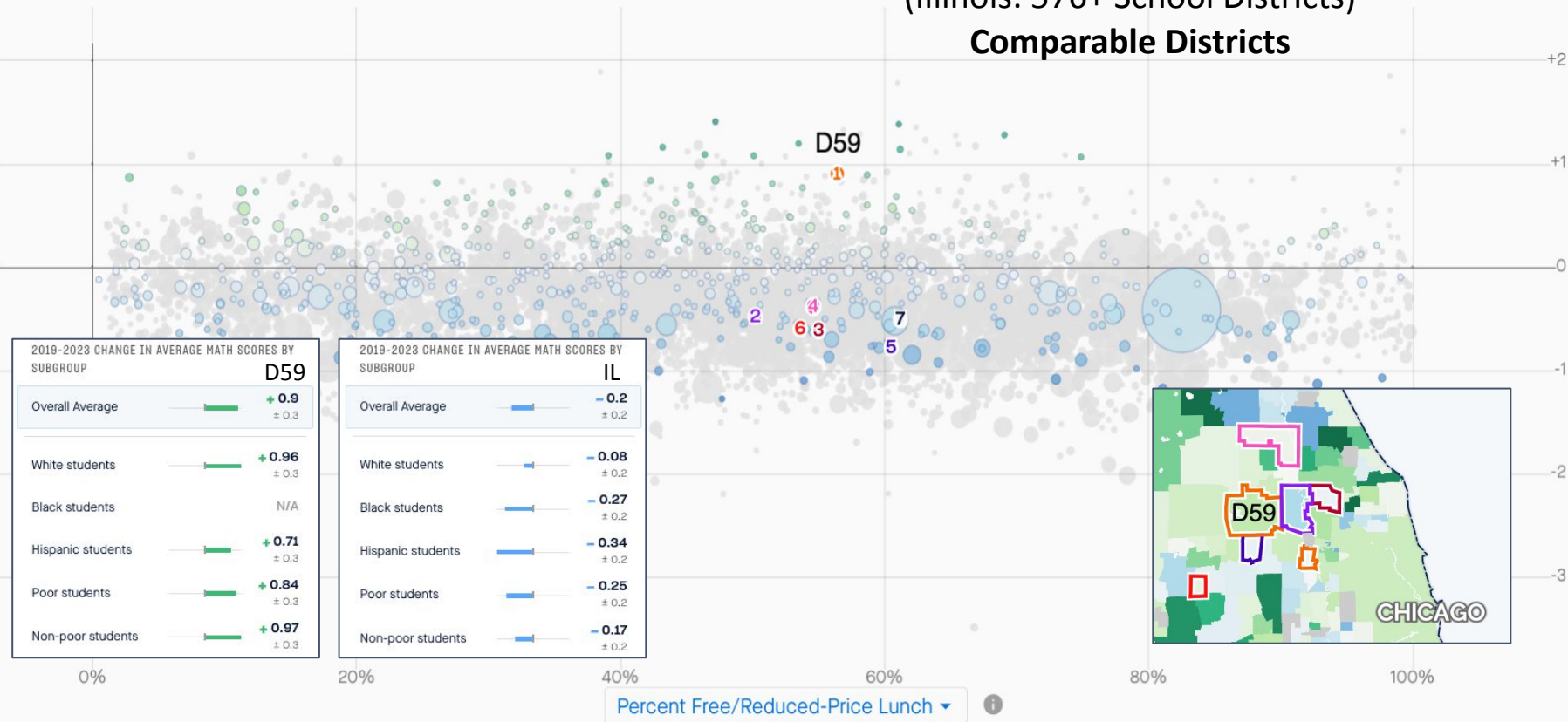


All Students' 2019-2023 Change in Average Math Scores ▾

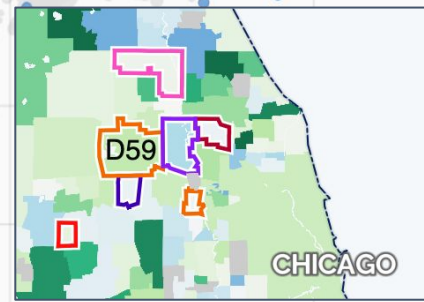

Strategic Plan Goal 1 - Student Growth & Achievement
KPI: 80% or more of students across all demographic groups will be adequately supported by Tier 1 instruction, as evidenced by the ~~Branching Minds~~ Tier Level Report.

Why - 80% of students supported by Tier 1 (i.e. students scoring ≥ 25 th percentile) can be viewed as the “Critical Mass” where the core curriculum & instructional strategies are effective in meeting grade level learning for most students.

WINTER BENCHMARKING REFLECTIONS



Reflections: Strengths & Positives

- A majority of students are on track to meet expected levels of Typical & Stretch Growth in math & reading
- Typical & Stretch Growth data indicates intervention structures & programs are positively impacting Tier 2 & Tier 3 students district-wide
- Overall achievement results compare as well or better to IL & national results with positive achievement growth across ALL categories.
- Positive fall to winter KPI increases in reading & math for the district (2/2), grade levels (10/18), schools (19/28), race/ethnicity (12/16) & demographic (18/18) groups [Overall 61/82 = 74.4%]

Reflections: Opportunities for Growth

- Results continue to show achievement gaps, with some quite significant, across schools & demographic groups
- While students 2 or more grades below grade level are outpacing other students in Typical Growth, their Stretch Growth remains in alignment or below other student groups
- Reading meeting end of year stretch growth fell behind 2022.23 winter results
- The overall district, all grade levels, and most demographics & schools results continue to fall below our 80% Tier 1 KPI target

Reflections: Actions & Analysis

- Ongoing analysis of intervention program impact by individual program and student growth by District MTSS Team
- School based analysis and planning from benchmark data have been and are occurring district-wide, including mid-year grade level sessions with an iReady facilitator
- Updated/additional coaching supports based on mid-year data review
- Facilitated an analysis of growth for students in interventions with school intervention staff
- Completed a mid-year benchmark data & implementation review with our iReady support & implementation team
- Conducting additional analysis around grade levels that have had consistent limited or lower growth over the last few years
