# Enrichment Courses

Held at both Devonshire and Salt Creek

## **Priority Students identified for early registration (February 12 - 23)**

- Students receiving tier 2 and 3 interventions
- Students receiving special education services who do not qualify for ESY

## **Open to ALL students in early March**

- Student enrollment is based on staff availability

# Elementary Enrichment Courses

Designed to give students a “jump start” into content and skills they will learn next year

## PreK

### **Kindergarten Kickstart!**

Students will develop a sense of curiosity and excitement as they prepare for kindergarten.

## K

### **Community Connections!**

Students will learn about their community and the power of coming together to care for people, plants, and animals in their community.

## 1st

### **Smart Spenders Academy!**

Students will make informed choices between needs and wants by working to set a goal to enhance their community.

## 2nd

### **Fossil Detectives!**

Students will explore the past through fossils to investigate the extinction of living things.

## 3rd

### **Ecosystem Showdown!**

Students will learn how competition in ecosystems changes the population of living things.

## 4th

### **POWERful Exploration!**

Students will learn how energy flows and transfers in order to power our world.
