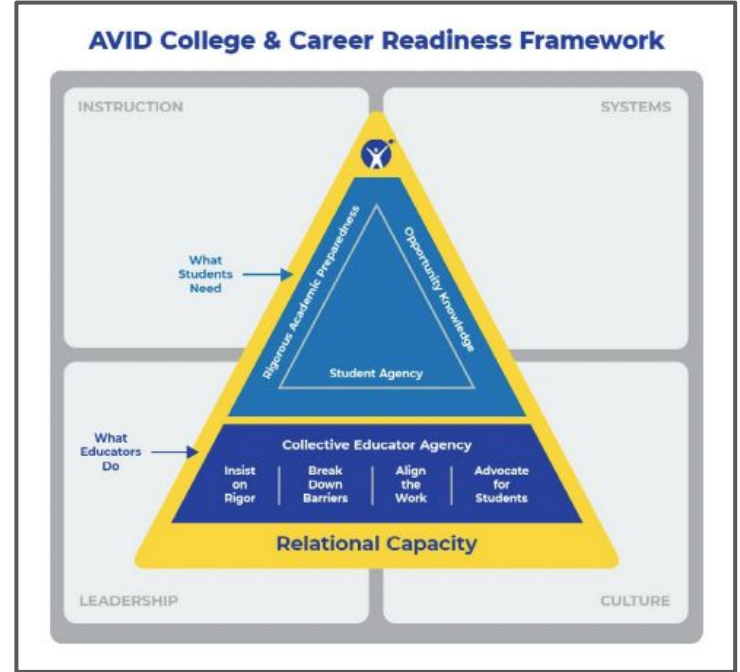
# What is AVID?

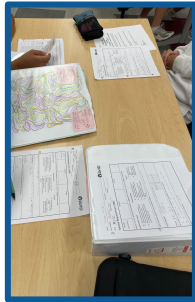
